Attendance

As explained to parents/carers before Christmas, we have now adopted the Felpham and Bognor Schools Locality Attendance Protocol in line with all of the other schools across Bognor. This information can be found on the school website and is in line with our own Attendance Policy. We have also appointed a new Attendance Officer who will monitor weekly attendance for all children. Attendance, currently, for many children, is too low and whilst we acknowledge genuine illness and appointments, parents/carers must communicate with us daily to ensure that we have the full details of the reason they are absent. Thank you to those parents who always call in every day. Holidays in term time will not be authorised and will be subject to a Fixed Penalty Notice. An absence form is available from the school office. Regular days off school equates to valuable learning lost and hampers children's progress. The taught National Curriculum is content heavy and so some aspects won't be repeated. Thank you.
