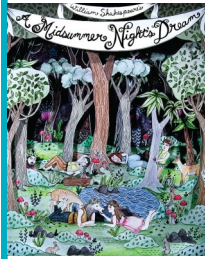

## Year 5 & 6 QuadKids Athletic Event



On the 7th and 12th June, the QuadKids teams (one Yrs 3 & 4 team and one Yrs 5 & 6 team) represented Bartons at TRS in the locality sports event. The teams took part in the long jump, throwing and sprinting and the 600m race. Throughout the afternoon, all of the children demonstrated enthusiasm, resilience and amazing team spirit. They loved every moment and there were some stand out performances. Archie L was in the top 3 fastest boys for the sprint and Archie H was in the top 3 for the throwing event. Sam performed strongly the whole afternoon and ended up placing 4th overall in all of the events out of 65 boys. Amazing effort from everyone. The final team placings were:

- Years 5 & 6 finished 10/11 schools
