This week, we have certainly felt the chilly drop in temperature and although it is lovely to see blue sky and sunshine in the

mornings, it is very cold outside first thing in the morning. Please ensure that your child has a hat, scarf and gloves (all or some) which are named, so that they can stay warm. Even in the winter months, the children will go outdoors to play at break times. With Covid-19 still hanging around, we are still ensuring that the classrooms are well ventilated and cleaned throughout the day. If your child is feeling chilly in the classroom then they can put an extra layer of clothing under their uniform. Coats and hoodies are not suitable to be worn inside during class learning times.

Recently, several children have had symptoms of sickness and headache and then tested positive. Please use LFT 's to check if you are ensure and if your child has a positive LFT result AND is unwell (WITH symptoms) then please book a PCR test. Rates of positive tests have to be reported to the Department for Education.
