New House Captains

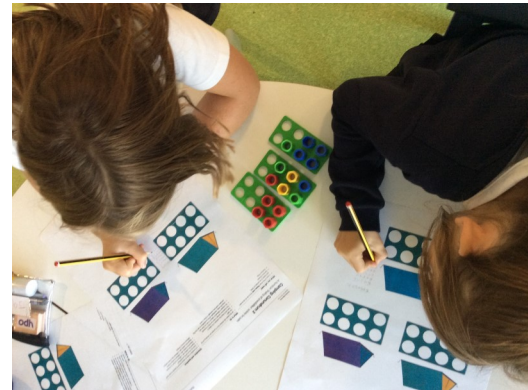
