PARENTS EVENING BOOKINGS

This term we are happy to return to face-to-face parent consultation sessions. The dates are on the school website and calendar dates sent out last month. This year, all bookings need to be made on ParentMail and booking will be enabled on **Monday 18th October at 9am**. On the evenings, in order to limit the amount of people in the building, we would like parents to enter the school site through the main gate (by Elm class) and wait outside your child's classroom door outside. The teacher will invite you into the classroom when they are ready and parents will need to exit via the same classroom door and leave the site through the exit gate by the playground. We hope to see you all there.

EARLY MORNING CLUB CHANGES

After half-term, we will be moving towards online booking and payment facility for early Morning Club using ParentMail. This is at the request of parents and will streamline the system for school staff. As you know, we offer Early Morning Club to working parents with a cost of $\pounds 1$ per session. Paying online will make it easier and ensure that we have registers for the children each morning. Next week we will let you know how it works and how to book.

STARTING PRIMARY & SECONDARY SCHOOL 2022

The windows for applying for school places in 2022 are now open. If your child is starting primary school or secondary school next September then you will need to apply to West Sussex County Council for a school place. Here are the key dates for applications. Applications for secondary places close on Sunday 31st October 2021. Applications for primary places close on Saturday 15th January 2022. The National notification offer days are 1st March for secondary places and 16th April for Reception.
