School Start Times

I want to remind you all again that we will be changing the start of the school day **from the 3rd January** in accordance with the new guidance from the DfE, Children have to be in school 32.5 hours per week and so we need to adjust the time of the start of the school day.

There are signs all around school with this information on. It will be as follows:

- The gates will open at 8.35am.
- * Class doors will be open for the children at 8.40am
- * Children must be in class ready to learn by 8.45am.
- * The gates will be locked at 8.50am.
- * Late arrivals after 8.50am will be marked as late.

Early Morning Club times will not be affected. Please ensure that you will be ready for this change. Thank you.

Chartwells Hot Meal Ordering with ParentPay

You should now be in receipt of a paper copy of your activation code, to be able to log-in to ParentPay, to submit the hot meal options your child is having. Please note even if your child is bringing in a packed lunch from home this also needs to be logged too, as every child has to be accounted for. Please remember that this is a new system being introduced by West Sussex County Council and this is not the school's decision and we are unable to opt out. Currently 43% of parents have activated their accounts which equate to 89 activated and 117 not activated. We

have had some great feedback in how easy the new system is to use - thank you! Please do this as soon as you can because if you don't, you may have problems in the future.
