## Illness Absence

This half term, we have seen an increase in the normal seasonal illnesses as well as having a few cases of Covid-19 amongst pupils and staff. Currently, we have to report attendance and reasons for illness to the Department for Education daily and so when we don't have any messages from parents/carers about the children not being in school. this makes things very difficult for us. Please can I remind parents that you must telephone school or leave a message before 9am with a reason for their absence every day. This is stated clearly on our website. Many parents are not phoning school which means that the office staff have to spend a lot of time following up with many phone calls. There is an out of hours answer phone message system for you to leave messages on. Reasons for absence not received could result in an unauthorised absence being recorded. 10 unauthorised sessions could result in a Fixed Penalty Notice being issued by the Local Authority.
