Red, White and Blue Day: VE Day - 80 years Anniversary. Thursday 8th May



On Thursday, we celebrated the 80th anniversary of VE Day along with the nation. Everyone wore red, white and blue coloured clothes in support of remembering the sacrifice that was made by so many men and women 80 years ago so that peace could return to the world. In class, the children learnt about WW11 and what it would have been like at that time 80 years ago. They also explored some local war time history e.g. HMS Barbara which was based in Bognor. A small group of Year 6 children attended the commemoration at the Jubilee Hall, Bersted where the parish council were celebrating the anniversary and giving thanks. Our children read a poem written by the Cedar class about VE Day and took part in the minute silence whilst the flag was raised. The children showed great empathy and respect when thinking about the effect of the second world war on Britain and the world.
