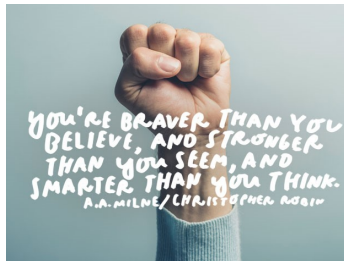

In order to streamline our communication systems to parents, we are changing our communication platform from ParentMail to **ParentPay**, the system you currently use to order hot school meals.
