Summer Production



On Tuesday 7th and Wednesday 8th July, Years 4, 5 & 6 will be performing their summer production

*There is an opportunity to bring any pre-school aged children to a free relaxed performance on Monday 6th July at 2pm. This performance is also for the rest of the school, therefore, due to limited space, it is only open to parents bringing pre-school aged children. **If you are planning on bringing very young children, please can we ask that if they become upset and are making a lot of noise, then please take them out of the hall so as not to disrupt the performance and put the performing children off.** If you would like to attend this performance, please contact Ms Camp on 01243 822056. This is so that we know numbers - you do not need a ticket for this performance.*

TICKET PRICES: £2.50 per ticket (these are virtual tickets - you will not be given a physical ticket, but your allocated tickets and names will be on the guest list). The price of the tickets will cover the costs of the performing licence which we have to have for this production.

Programmes can be purchased on the day for 50p.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to fire regulations, we are limited on the numbers of people we can have in the building, so there is a **maximum of 4 tickets per family for over the three performances. This is to ensure that everyone gets tickets fairly.** If you would like to go on the waiting list for extra tickets, please let Ms Camp know in the school office. Please do not order more than 4 tickets through the booking system because these will be cancelled.
