Colour Run 24th May 2pm - 4pm

The Colour Run Event will be held on Friday 24th May. The Friends of Bartons have done a great job planning this and we hope that the children will enjoy it. For children not taking part in the event, there will be an alternative fun activity in school with school staff until the end of the normal school day. The funds raised will be going towards new outdoor reading equipment that the School Council have requested.

Because of the nature of this activity, there are some specific rules that have to be strictly adhered to.

- Eye protection must be worn and a waiver must be signed.
- Please bring your own hand sanitiser and wipes/towel. Face masks will be available for use.
- Children will not be allowed to enter the building after starting the race. Toilets will not be available for use.
- For those taking part, please bring old clothes to change into. These clothes may be ruined and will get stained.
- At the end of the race, children may leave but must tell their teacher when they are leaving school and with whom.
- For children in Year R to Year 4, they must have an adult at the event with them to supervise their child/ren's run.
- Years 5 & 6 will not require parental supervision. Years 5 and 6 races won't start until after school has ended. Those pupils can stay at school in preparation for their race. Ensure that they know whether they are walking home or being collected. Race times by class are:
- Year R 14:15 14:30
- Year 1 14:30 14:45
- Year 2 14:45 15:00
- Year 3 15:00 15:15
- Year 4 15:15 15:30
- Year 5 15:30 15:45
- Year 6 15:45 16:00

On completion of the course, each runner will receive a certificate and some treats. The FoBs would love more volunteers so if you can help on the day, do let us know asap.
