Please would parents remember that any absence from school must be requested <u>5 days before</u> it is needed on our agreed form. It must not be done on the day or afterwards. We do expect families to be truthful and holidays, days out and birthdays will NOT be authorised in school time. Pupils are only in school for 190 days each year. There are 175 other days for holidays and other activities. 80% attendance represents 1 day off every week. 90% attendance represents 1 day off every fortnight.
