Moving From ParentMail to ParentPay IMPORTANT

In order to streamline our communication systems to parents, we will be changing our communication platform from ParentMail to ParentPay, the system you currently use to order hot school meals. This will be for all of our future emails, texts and payments etc. This will take effect from 1st June 2023. This will mean that after 1st June, we will not use ParentMail anymore. If you have not already done so, you must activate your ParentPay account with the code you were given previously. We encourage you do this as soon as possible in advance of the changeover and this going 'live'. You must have this in order to receive any school messages and all communications.
