Momo Challenge

Recently, there has been a lot of media attention with regard to the 'Momo challenge' aimed at primary school aged children. It is the latest in a series of chain-letter viral stories. It has a disturbing image that represents the Momo character which can frighten children. Players who want to take part search online for a number to text or Whatsapp. Once they have sent the first message they get replies including challenges to commit self-harm or suicide as well as grotesque images. Sussex Police have informed us that whilst this is alarming, the occurrences seem rare. There have been a number of press reports about it being linked to suicides and self- harm but currently there is no evidence of direct harm caused by the game. I have put some guidance from The National Online Safety group on the school website (in the Parents section) about social media to help parents know what to do and say. Please do monitor your child's screen time and talk to them if you have any concerns. I have attached a leaflet which explains more about this.
